Types of Enrollment

• Traditional

Select from a variety of fall, spring, and year round courses. These courses have a set start and end date and follow a traditional school year calendar.

• On Demand

On Demand courses allow for a personalized pace and are available year round. Students are enrolled on the 1st & 15th of every month and have up to 6 months to complete a 0.5 credit course.

• Home Study

Choose from a combination of teacher and/or parent facilitated courses to meet the expectations of your home study plan.

• Full-Time Online

Collaborative Diploma Program, CDP: This program allows students in tuition towns the option of earning their high school diploma online from a geographically distant Vermont public high school.

Partner Diploma Program, PDP: This program allows for students who are enrolled at a VT VLC partner school to earn their diploma online. (Please check the availability of PDP at your school or contact VT VLC).

• Design Your Own Course

Personalized Assessment of Student Standards (PASS): Allows students to work with VT VLC, their school and a teacher mentor to create their own course and get high school credit for it!

How Does VTVLC Work?

Vermont Virtual works with Vermont schools to facilitate online courses for students statewide. All courses are facilitated by Vermont licensed educators who also hold the Online Teaching Specialist Endorsement. Because of this, our courses are considered (and treated) as any traditional/local course, and the credit students earn are considered 'transfer credits'.

Our main goal is to overcome the three barriers that prevent students from taking courses they need; **availability, accessibility, and flexibility.**

Marine Biology - Research in Bermuda



Marine Biology is a 1 credit hybrid course. Students study marine science online during the spring semester, with some face to face meetings to prepare for a 1 week research trip to Bermuda during the summer months.
