What is the LI Shooting Club?

Formed in 2015 the LI Shooting Club, part of the NEK Clayshooters, offers shotgun clay target shooting to LI students. Everyone is welcome.

Where and When do I shoot?

We shoot at the Northeast Kingdom Skeet Club (NEKSC) located in Burke Hollow. They donate the use of their modern clay target shooting facilities to the NEK Clayshooters. We shoot one day a week from April thru May and September thru October.

Do I need to be an experienced shooter/ own a shotgun?

NO, our club has its own shotguns for club members to use. Our NRA certified coaches teach shotgun clay target shooting and safe gun handling skills.

Where are the guns and ammo kept?

All guns and ammo are kept in the NEK Clayshooters gun safe at the NEKSC range in Burke Hollow. All guns and ammo are in the control of the coaches.

Is it safe?

High school clay target shooting is yearly recognized as the safest high school sport in the country with **ZERO** injuries.

How do LI student club members get to the NEKSC shooting range?

LI students are bused from the LI Auto Tech building at 3:15 PM and return back by 5:45 PM.

Clay target shooting teaches responsibility, physical and mental discipline, hand and eye coordination, and decision-making skills. It is a sport of concentration and it is FUN!

What does it cost to join the NEK Clayshooters?

The club supplies the shotguns, ammo, safety glasses, ear protection, and targets FREE. There is an annual \$25 student club membership fee. Scholarships are available.
